

WOMEN'S LAND ARMY.

CONDITIONS AND TERMS.

There are three Sections of the Women's Land Army:

- (1). AGRICULTURE.
- (2). TIMBER CUTTING.
- (3). FORAGE.

If you sign on for A YEAR and are prepared to go wherever you are sent, you can join which Section you like.

YOU PROMISE—

1. To sign on in the Land Army for ONE YEAR.
2. To come to a Selection Board when summoned.
3. To be medically examined, free of cost.
4. To be prepared if PASSED by the Selection Board to take up work after due notice.
5. TO BE WILLING TO GO TO WHATEVER PART OF THE COUNTRY YOU ARE SENT.

THE GOVERNMENT PROMISES—

1. AN INITIAL WAGE to workers of 20/- a week. After they have passed an efficiency test the wages given are 22/- a week and upwards.
2. A short course of FREE INSTRUCTION if necessary.
3. FREE UNIFORM.
4. FREE MAINTENANCE in a Depot for a term not exceeding 4 weeks if the worker is OUT OF EMPLOYMENT through no fault of her own.
5. FREE RAILWAY travelling, when taking up or changing Employment.

OR,

If you sign on for only six months, you can join the Agricultural and Timber Cutting Sections, but not the Forage.

YOU PROMISE—

1. To sign on in the Land Army for 6 MONTHS.
2. To come to a Selection Board when summoned.
3. To be medically examined, free of cost.
4. To be prepared if PASSED by the Selection Board to take up work after due notice.
5. TO BE WILLING TO GO TO ANY PART OF THE COUNTRY YOU ARE SENT.

THE GOVERNMENT PROMISES—

1. AN INITIAL WAGE of 20/- per week.
2. UNIFORM FREE.
3. FREE MAINTENANCE in a Depot for a term not exceeding 2 weeks, if the worker is out of employment through no fault of her own.
4. FREE RAILWAY travelling when taking up or changing employment.

NOTE.—No training is given, therefore the initial wage is only 20/-. Should the worker be able to pass an efficiency test, it will be raised to 22/-. Two weeks' maintenance in a depot only is allowed.
